Who Should Attend?

Certified nursing assistants wanting a refresher course on basic skills and changes in the program or nurse aides who need to be recertified or certified for the first time who have completed a state approved nurse aide program that meets Department of Health and Human Services Regulation (DHRS) requirements.

Goals:

This course prepares students who need a review prior to taking the state exam for nurse aide certification. The student must have completed a state approved nurse aide program that meets Department of Health and Human Services Regulation requirements.

Course Objectives:

- Accurately perform all 24 skills required for the state exam
- Identify effective verbal and nonverbal communication skills
- Apply the basic principles of infection control
- Identify safety measures that prevent accidents to residents
- Explain the different types of abuse with examples of each and how to report instances
- Define a therapeutic diet and list 5 purposes of a therapeutic diet
- Identify common diseases and conditions
- Describe the nurse aide's role in keeping the resident's unit safe, clean, and conducive to overall health
- List the daily hygienic needs of an individual
- Explain the role of the nurse aide as it relates to the dying process
- Discuss the methods to prevent pressure ulcers
- Demonstrate basic restorative principles
