What is Integrative Pastoral Psychotherapy?

This continuing education course is an introduction to the biological – psychological – systemic- spiritual model of pastoral psychotherapy. Counseling theory, techniques, and clinical use of self are addressed through a collaborative perspective which integrates the literature of psychotherapy, medicine, body energy, cybernetics, systems, theology and spirituality. The teaching is drawn from psychotherapy, supervision, medicine (psychiatry, sleep medicine, and collaborative family medicine) as well as Healing Touch. This course is designed to meet requirements of the American Association of Pastoral Counselors Fellow Body of Knowledge Area 1. Core Clinical Theory.

Course Objectives:

- To explore the literature of integrative pastoral psychotherapy
- To develop a personal integrative perspective and theory of pastoral psychotherapy
- To apply one's personal theory of integrative pastoral psychotherapy to the use of self and interventions within the respective clinical placement
- To understand how integrative pastoral psychotherapy correlates within a multidisciplinary clinical setting
- To develop cultural, ethical, and legal competency utilizing an integrative pastoral psychotherapy model.

Who should attend?

Professional counselors, psychotherapists, and lay counselors/caregivers who seek to integrate a faith based, collaborative model within a complex clinical setting particularly one that interfaces with the medical community.
