What is Spiritual Formation in Pastoral Psychotherapy?

This course is an introduction to the understanding the premise that spiritual formation occurs uniquely within everyone intentionally or otherwise. This course is designed to assist participants to: 1.) Understand patterns and expressions of the spiritual component within the participant and also within the persons with whom they provide pastoral psychotherapy. 2.) Understand how pastoral psychotherapists might integrate the skills and interventions used by spiritual directors within their own clinical context. This course is designed to meet requirements for the American Association of Pastoral Counselors Fellow Body of Knowledge, Area II.B.3. Spirituality and Spiritual Formation.

Why should I take this class?

Participants will learn the perspectives and clinical skills of spiritual direction and apply them to the psychotherapy.

Psychotherapists, professional counselors, and lay counselors/caregivers who desire to apply the perspective and clinical skills directions to counseling and psychotherapy.
