GOALS

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

1. Ninety percent of students receive a score of 80 percent or better on course tests and exams
2. One hundred percent of students receive a score of 80 percent or better on the Skill Competency Profile
3. One hundred percent of students will meet AST Clinical Case Requirements (minimum of 80 first scrub cases with at least 25 of the 80 performed in the solo role)
4. First time certification pass rates are at or above 90 percent; PAE pass rates are at or above 90 percent.
